Dear Entrant

Congratulations and thank you for your interest in entering the 2017 Warwick Rodeo Queen Quest.

The Warwick Rodeo Queen is an ambassador of the Warwick Rodeo and Campdraft. During the week of the Rodeo and Campdraft, Warwick Rodeo Queen entrants are invited as ambassadors to attend a number of events, these events attract media attention and will provide the opportunity to promote our event through interviews and photo opportunities. The winner of the 2017 Warwick Rodeo Queen wins the opportunity to fly to Canada and/or America to represent "Australia's Most Famous Rodeo" as the Warwick Rodeo Queen.*

Warwick Rodeo is well known as "Australia's Most Famous" Rodeo and in 2017 we are again home to the 'APRA National Finals Rodeo'. Once again we will be joined by Miss Rodeo Australia, Miss Rodeo Canada and Miss Rodeo America. The Warwick Rodeo and Campdraft week will commence Monday 23 October 2017.

There have been a few small changes to how our Quest will be run in 2017. Judging will return to the one weekend format consisting of a mandatory informal meet and greet dinner on Friday night 13 October followed by the horsemanship workouts, interviews and the presentation evening on Saturday 14 October 2017.

This year there will be a "mother" assigned to each age group to act as a coordinator, mentor and the communication channel between entrants and the committee. The names of age group coordinators will be released closer to the event.

In 2017 to be eligible for any title Queen Entrants are required to fundraise a minimum of \$1,000 and Princess Entrants are required to fundraise a minimum of \$250. We want to encourage you to enter and get your fundraising underway early, if you require suggestions on fundraising ideas please contact the committee. All entrants will be issued with a bank deposit book so you can deposit your fundraising efforts directly into the Societies bank account. Monies raised at any fundraising event must be banked into the Societies bank account within seven (7) business days after the fundraising has occurred, failure to do so may result in those funds not being counted towards your final tally. The winner of the Overall Fundraiser will be crowned with the Perpetual Overall Fundraiser Crown to be worn for the year as the title holder.

Note: Judging and Appearance Attire – Good Casual Western or Australia Attire is to be worn during judging and the week of Rodeo and Campdraft events. This may include dresses or skirts where appropriate. You are not required to wear or purchase White Jeans for any occasion. Blue and/or Coloured are equally acceptable.
