## **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. Entries will **ONLY** be accepted on payment of fees and completion of the official entry form and the GST Hobby Form.
2. An EXHIBIT is the actual article to be shown.
3. **Exhibits will be received at the Kevin Thumpkin Pavilion between 4.00pm and 6.00pm on Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2018 or at the Secretarial Office prior to this date.**
4. Only three (3) items in each class per exhibitor.
5. Prize Money will be collected at the same time as collecting exhibits.
6. NO prize money will be posted unless the exhibitor resides 50km or more from Warwick.
7. It is the judge's decision as to whether prizes are awarded in a section or a class. All exhibitors **MUST** abide by the judge's decision.
8. If there are no more than four (4) entries in a class only one prize may be awarded.
9. All exhibits must be clean and ready for display.
10. The exhibit must be completely the **OWN WORK** of the exhibitor.
11. All entries must have been completed within the last twelve months.
12. Exhibits must **NOT** have been shown at a previous Warwick Annual Show.
13. The committee reserves the right to reject any exhibit or exhibits which may be considered not of sufficient merit to be displayed.
14. The Steward and/or Judge reserves the right to change the class of an exhibit.
15. The Novice Section is open to competitors who have never won a prize in the relevant class.
16. **Exhibits will be available for collection from 5pm Saturday and between 9am and 10am on Sunday 25<sup>th</sup> March 2018. This rule will be *strictly* observed. No item is to be removed without the Steward's approval. If a representative of the exhibitor collects the item a form must be filled out by the representative accepting responsibility for the item.**
17. Whilst the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society Inc. accepts **NO** responsibility for missing or damaged articles, all possible care will be taken with exhibits.
18. Exhibits may be sold following the judging with 15% commission payable to the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society.
19. The Pavilion will be open from 10.00am to 8.00pm on Friday 23 March, 10.00am to 8.00pm on Saturday 24 March, and 9am to 10am, Sunday 25 March 2018.
