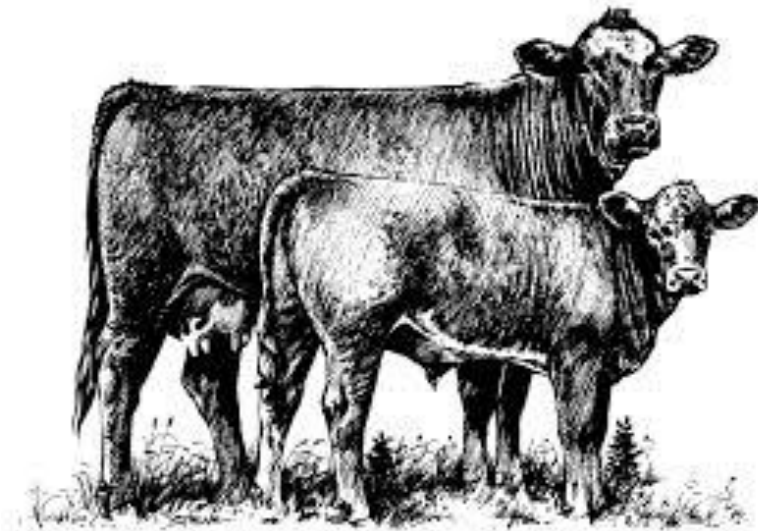

ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES

The attention of intending Exhibitors is drawn to the fact that entries are accepted subject to the Rules and the Constitution of this Society, in addition to the Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.

REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS

1. All cattle entered throughout this Section must be registered with their respective Breed Society, with the exception of entries in the led steer/heifer classes.
2. Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society will not be responsible for any losses, deaths, or accidents to stock.
3. **Bedding will NOT be provided. Exhibitors are required to provide their own bedding and feed.**
4. **Stud Cattle will be judged in Tropical, British and European groups/classes, and not in individual Breeds.**
5. Ages of cattle entered for competition shall be taken as at **1st March 2018.**
6. Calves to be entered in a single class or with mother only.
7. Stud heifers are not eligible to participate in the led steer/heifer classes.
8. If doubt should arise in the mind of the judge, in any Class, as to the classification of a competing animal, the matter will be referred to the Stewards of the particular sub section for consideration.
9. All cattle to be the bona-fide property of the Exhibitor.
10. All cattle under 6 months must be led by a halter. **All cattle over 6 months MUST be led by a halter and nose ring/grip. Bulls over 10 months MUST have a nose ring.** All stock MUST be in the charge of the exhibitor or his representative at all times.
11. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that the leaders of their stock in judging rings and paraders are capable of exercising control over the animals in their care.
12. All stalled cattle must be secured with neck collars and halters.
13. **All animals must have NLIS identification.**
14. **A copy of your waybill must be handed to the Chief Steward.**
15. All exhibitors to have Public Liability Insurance and to have same endorsed for traveling to Shows.
16. Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and all power boards must be tested and tagged.
17. Stewards have the right to remove any animal from the Judging Ring if that animal is a danger to the safety of the public.
18. No drug, hormone or tranquillizer shall be administered to any animal except under the direction of the Society's Veterinary Surgeon whom will advise the Stewards.
19. All cattle must comply with health requirements as stipulated by Biosecurity Queensland.

STUD EXHIBITORS PLEASE NOTE THE FOLLOWING CONDITIONS APPLYING TO ALL CATTLE

1. TUBERCULOSIS – Cattle must originate from a property, classified by the Chief Veterinary Officer of the State, as free of Tuberculosis.
2. BRUCELLOSIS – Cattle must be confirmed free, tested negative or monitored negative.
3. TRICHOMONIASIS – Breeding Cattle must be from a herd in which Trichomoniasis is not known to exist.
4. JOHNES DISEASE – Cattle must not be introduced unless they are from a property or herd in which Johnes' disease has not been known, or suspected to exist, during the five year period prior to the Show.

Any animal, which in the opinion of the Stewards is not in a fit state to be exhibited, may be rejected by them and debarred from competing in the class or classes for which it is entered. Any animal rejected must be removed from the Showgrounds as soon as the exhibitor is notified.

IMPORTANT NOTE TO ALL EXHIBITORS

In the interests of public safety, the committee has directed that there be **no washing of animals** at the wash bay 1 hour prior to and during the Auction of Prime Cattle and Presentation of Trophies on the afternoon of Friday 23rd March. We thank you for your cooperation.

12. PAIR OF BULLS - 2 Animals of same sex to be represented and must be owned by the Exhibitor, and must have been shown in the general classes.
13. PAIR OF FEMALES - 2 Animals of same sex to be represented and must be owned by the Exhibitor, and must have been shown in the general classes.
