All wool must not be removed until 4pm Saturday March 24th

Although every care will be taken with exhibits,

NO responsibility can be accepted for wool left on the Showground's.

CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. The classes are Extra Superfine, Superfine, Fine, Medium or Strong.
2. The Fleeces are to be skirted to the Judge's satisfaction.
3. ALL Fleeces, unless otherwise stated, shall be judged on the following points:

a) Trueness to type	10
b) Conformity of Length	10
c) Soundness	10
d) Handle	8
e) Colour or Bloom etc.	6
f) Character and Style	10
g) Density	6
h) Evenness	10
i) Clean Fleece Weight	30
	100
j) Three matching Fleeces (Evenness of matching)	50
<u>TOTAL SCORE</u>	150
4. The Judge has the right to reject any fleece which he considers is more than 12 months wool, or consists of more than one fleece
5. All Fleeces exhibited must be shorn in the twelve months prior to the date of the Show.
6. Any subject not covered by the above is to be decided by the Committee.
7. Any Fleece in the Show to be eligible for the appropriate Championship.
8. The Judge shall have the right to make no award in Classes in which he considers the entry unworthy of an award.
9. NO stud fleeces will be allowed entry to the Flock Fleece classes.

THE CHAMPION OF CHAMPIONS TROPHY

The Champion Local Flock Fleece from South-East Zone will be judged at the 2018 Warwick Show. The Trophy Winner will have his/her name inscribed on The Rosenthal Cup. All champion fleeces from other Show Societies are eligible for the Champion of Champions Trophy, but are NOT ELIGIBLE to compete in other classes at the Warwick Show.

FLOCK FLEECE - MERINO WOOL CLASSES

1. EXTRA SUPERFINE - Ewe or Wether
2. SUPERFINE - Ewe or Wether
3. FINE - Ewe or Wether
4. MEDIUM - Ewe or Wether
5. STRONG/EXTRA STRONG - Ewe or Wether
6. THREE FINE/SUPERFINE MATCHING FLEECES
7. THREE MEDIUM MATCHING FLEECES
8. THREE STRONG/EXTRA STRONG MATCHING FLEECES - *NB. In the above three classes (6, 7 & 8) emphasis is to be on matching of wool characteristics, not evenness of weight between the three fleeces.*
9. WEANER'S WOOL - Unshorn showing lamb's tip and to be in the opinion of the judge, a genuine weaner type.
10. COMMERCIAL FLEECE – Skirted.
