Conditions of Entry

- I. Entries will ONLY be accepted on payment of fees & completion of the entry form.
 - II. An EXHIBIT is the actual article to be shown.
 - III. Exhibits and Entry fees will be received at the Pavilion between **3pm - 6pm on Tuesday 15th March** OR phone me to make alternative arrangements; Entries will NOT be received at the show office.
 - IV. A limit of three (3) items per class per person.
 - V. Prize Money will be collected at the same time as collecting exhibits.
 - VI. NO prize money will be posted unless the exhibitor resides 50km or more from Warwick.
 - VII. It's the judge's decision as to whether prizes are awarded in a section or a class. ALL exhibitors MUST abide by the judge's decision.
 - VIII. If there are no more than three (3) entries in a class only one prize will be awarded.
 - IX. Cleanliness of all exhibits is essential; exhibits must be new and unused.
 - X. The exhibits must NOT have been washed (with the exception of exhibits from the spinning section) or worn.
 - XI. The exhibit must be completely the OWN WORK of the exhibitor, with the exception for professionally quilted quilts.
 - XII. An ARTICLE is something NOT WORN, a GARMENT is a piece of CLOTHING.
 - XIII. All entries must have been completed within the last two (2) years.
 - XIV. Exhibits must NOT have been shown at a previous Warwick Show.
 - XV. Only 3 entries per class per exhibitor
 - XVI. Committee reserves the right to reject any exhibit/exhibits which may be considered not of sufficient merit.
 - XVII. The Steward and/or Judge reserve the right to change the class of an article or garment.
 - XVIII. A Novice is someone new to the hobby or craft in the last twelve (12) months.
 - XIX. Exhibits will be available for collection from **9am to 12 noon on Sunday 20th March 2022**. This rule will be strictly observed. No item is to be removed without the Steward's approval. If a representative of the exhibitor collects the item a form must be filled out by the representative accepting responsibility for the item.
 - XX. Whilst the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society Inc. accepts NO responsibility for missing or damaged articles, all possible care will be taken with exhibits.
 - XXI. All framed articles must be suitable to hang safely or will not be accepted.
 - XXII. All quilts are to have a 4 inch rod pocket attached for hanging, (can be securely pinned using safety pins only). Quilts will not be accepted without rod pocket in place whether hung or laid for display.
 - XXIII. Exhibits may be sold following the judging with 15% commission payable to the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society. You must provide your own for sale sticker and price tag for the item.
 - XXIV. Names and labels on quilts MUST be covered with a fabric square. Entries are ticked on arrival, no names tags please
 - XXV. Many hours work go into preparing the schedule for you to take home on Sunday morning with your exhibits. Some classes will change, some will stay the same. I am always open to suggestions for different classes. This gives you a full 12 months to work on your entries as per the schedule for the following year's show. Entries that do not fit a class will be displayed only.
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Section A - ASSORTED

1. Tatting - Needle or Shuttle - any item or decoration on a garment
2. Mosaic - tile, pot plant, coffee table
3. Latch Hook – cushion, table runner or wall hanging - Cushion to have insert, wall hanging ready to hang.
4. Diamond Art – must be framed or finished article

Section C - CROCHET

5. Knee rug – any medium
6. Table Centre, Tray Cloth or Doyley any medium
7. Scarf- any medium
8. 1 pair Socks, slippers, mittens, or gloves
9. Shawl or Wrap - any medium
10. Baby Shawl or blanket
11. Amigurumi - toy or animal - any medium
12. Broomstick crochet beanie and scarf set.
13. Tunisian Crochet garment or article
14. Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section D - DISABLED

15. Any Item listed in schedule.

Section E - EMBROIDERY

16. Wool Embroidery - wool embroidery on a garment or article
17. Crewel Embroidery - any article
18. Any other form of embroidery – eg: assisi, hardanger
19. Cross Stitch - Picture must be framed finished article
20. Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section F - FELTING

21. Needle Felting - article or garment decorated or made with the needle felting technique
22. Nuno felting - any item or garment made using the nuno felting technique
23. Small item using the wet felting technique

Section H - HISTORICAL CLOTHING – Med Pre-17th Century

24. Hand stitched pouch made of leather or natural fibre suitable for hanging off a belt or tying around the waist
25. Hood made from natural fibre that would cover the neck and shoulders. Please supply foam head for display.
26. Hand stitched and embroidered linen table napkin or handkerchief
27. Leather belt or jewelled girdle belt

Section J - JUNIOR- Under 16 years

28. Patchwork - pencil case - must have a zipper closure
29. Patchwork - cushion - front pieced and the back include a zipper, NOT buttons - must have insert
30. Sewing - soft toy

Section K - KNITTING

31. Adult Jumper or Cardigan – any medium
32. Scarf - any medium
33. Vest - any size, any ply
34. Knitted Toy - any medium
35. 1 x Pair of Socks, Gloves or Mittens
36. Baby blanket or shawl
37. Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section M – MACHINE SEWING

38. Childs Dress / Sun Frock - 4 to 8 years
39. Babies outfit under 12 months (Dress, Rompers or Overalls)
40. Adult blouse with collar and button front
41. Soft Toy
42. Novelty Item- pin cushion/coat hanger/casserole dish cover etc
43. Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section S - SPINNING

44. WOVEN Scarf using hand spun fibre
45. Adult Jumper, Cardigan or Jacket using hand spun fibre
46. Scarf, Shawl or Wrap, knit or crochet, using hand spun fibre.
47. Crochet knee rug or blanket
48. Socks or Mittens, Gloves, Cap or Beanie - knit or crochet using hand spun fibre
49. Skein of spun fibre, with a 10cm (4") square knit crochet or woven sample. Please state what the fibre is.
50. Knee rug – knit or crochet from hand spun fibre

Section P - PATCHWORK & QUILTING

51. Traditional Quilt - Machine Pieced - Machine Quilted - MUST have a 4" rod pocket for hanging
52. Traditional Quilt - Machine or Hand pieced - HAND Quilted - MUST have 4" rod Pocket for hanging Class
53. Patchwork / Quilted Table Runner, centre or Placemats
54. Patchwork Bag / Purse
55. Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section W - WEAVING

56. Hand Woven Item or Garment - any fibre
57. Woven scarf, wrap or shawl – any fibre

Section Z - CHALLENGE – Tea cosy

58. Tea cosy, any medium. For display purposes please include the teapot.
