**Conditions:**

- I. Exhibits received between 7:30am to 9:30am Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> March.
- II. Entries close Fri 11<sup>th</sup> March, NO late entries will be accepted.
- III. Entries will ONLY be accepted on payment of fees and completion of the official entry form.
- IV. An EXHIBIT is the actual article to be shown.
- V. Prize Money MUST be collected during the Show - prize money winnings will be null and void at the end of April 2022
- VI. NO prize money will be posted unless the exhibitor resides 50km or more from Warwick.
- VII. Where there are less than three (3) entries in a class only one (1) prize will be awarded.
- VIII. Cleanliness of all exhibits is essential.
- IX. The exhibit must be completely the OWN WORK of the exhibitor.
- X. All entries must have been completed within the last two (2) years.
- XI. Exhibits must NOT have been shown at a previous Warwick Annual Show/s.
- XII. The committee reserves the right to reject any exhibit/s which may be considered not of sufficient merit to be displayed.
- XIII. All exhibitors MUST abide by the judge's decision as to whether prizes are awarded in a section or a class.
- XIV. Kevin Thumpkin Pavilion will be open 9am-8pm Friday 18<sup>th</sup> March and 9am-6pm Saturday 19<sup>th</sup> March 2022
- XV. **Exhibits will be available for collection from 8.00am-10.00am on Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> March 2022.** This rule will be **strictly** observed. If a representative of the exhibitor collects the item a form must be filled out by that person accepting responsibility for the item.
- XVI. Whilst the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society Inc. accepts NO responsibility for missing or damaged articles, all possible care will be taken with exhibits.
- XVII. All framed articles must be suitable to hang safely.
- XVIII. Any exhibits requiring a posted return will be required to supply a stamped self-addressed envelope on entry of the article/exhibit.
- XIX. Articles/Exhibits may be sold following the judging with 15% commission payable to the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society Inc. You must provide your own for sale sticker and price tag for the item. Sold exhibits cannot be collected until Sunday 20<sup>th</sup> March 2022.
