Regulations & Conditions

- **All exhibitors must have the Biosecurity Health Declaration printed and completed. This is to be submitted when submitting your entries, & or handed to Chief Steward once at the Showgrounds. This is a mandatory requirement.**
 - **All animals must have NLIS identification. Warwick Show Society will scan NLIS devices on Saturday 25th & a copy of your waybill must be handed to the Steward when cattle NLIS are scanned.**
 - All cattle entered throughout this Section must be registered with their respective Breed Society, with the exception entries in the led steer/heifer classes.
 - All Stud Cattle will be judged in British, European and Bos Indicus breed groups & not as individual breeds. Supreme Champions, Exhibitors Groups and Pairs classes will be judged as an Interbreed competition.
 - **SAWDUST BEDDING WILL BE PROVIDED.** The small increase of entry fees is to cover the costing of bedding being provided.
 - **Ages of cattle** entered for competition shall be taken as at 1st March, 2023
 - Calves to be entered in a single class or with mother only. Maximum age of calf to be shown as calf at foot to be 9 months.
 - Stud heifers are not eligible to participate in the led steer/heifer classes.
 - If doubt should arise in the mind of the judge, in any Class, as to the classification of a competing animal, the matter will be referred to the Stewards of the particular sub section for consideration.
 - All cattle to be the bona-fide property of the Exhibitor.
 - **All cattle over 4 months MUST be led by a halter and nose ring/grip. Bulls over 10 months MUST have a nose ring. Any animal found not to have a nose ring/grip will be disqualified and no refund of entries will be given.**
 - It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that the leaders of their stock in judging rings and paraders are capable of exercising control over the animals in their care.
 - All stalled cattle must be secured with neck collars and halters.
 - Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society will not be responsible for any losses, deaths or accidents to stock & or equipment.
 - All exhibitors to have Public Liability Insurance and to have some endorsed for travelling to Shows.
 - Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be require to ensure the equipment is fitted with residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licenced electrical contractor and currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and power boards must be tested and tagged.
 - Stewards have the right to remove any animal from the Judging Ring if the animal is a danger to the safety of the public
 - All cattle must comply with the health requirements as stipulated by Biosecurity Queensland.

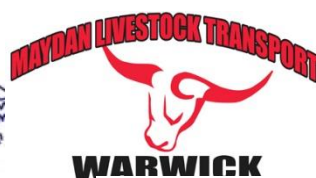
