Conditions of Entry & Rules

- I. Entries close Friday 24th March 2023
- II. **Entry Fee is:** \$10 per team
- III. **Entries** will ONLY be accepted on payment of fees and completion of the official entry.
- IV. Teams are made up of four people between the ages of 18 35 years.
- V. The competition is open to both male & female participants.
- VI. The Young Farmer Challenge teams will be made up of 4 people. Each minor challenge within the main challenge may require a different number of team members participating. ie. This challenge will be completed by 1,2,3 or 4 members of the team depending on the difficulty of the challenge.
- VII. Participants must adhere to Workplace, health & safety regulations etc. when, but not limited to, lifting or rolling of objects are required.
- VIII. All competitors must wear a shirt with sleeves (short or long), long pants and closed in shoes suitable for on-farm practical skills.
- IX. If PPE is required for the competition it will be supplied by the organizing committee.
- X. You must complete every challenge safely and using the appropriate footwear (covered) and Personnel Protective Equipment when required. Otherwise you will be penalized and the whole team will have to wait 30 secs before that challenge can be completed again.
- XI. The winning team will be the team that completes all of the challenges *correctly and safely* and in the fastest time.
- XII. The Young Farmers Challenge competition organizers have the right to refuse any team or team member's participation in the *Young Farmers Challenge*.
- XIII. Participants must at all times listen, respect, and agree to follow and adhere to the verbal and written instruction as outlined by he Competition Organizers, Stewards & Judges.
- XIV. A demonstration will be provided prior to the commencement of the competition to clarify the standards and requirements of each challenge.
- XV. Participants must stay in their team's designated area during the competition unless told otherwise by the Stewards.
- XVI. All participants must be sober and coherent and not under the influence of drugs and alcohol.
- XVII. Judges decision are final.
- XVIII. Participants must act respectfully and responsibly towards their team members and fellow participants and participate in the *Young Farmers Challenge* with the intent of goodwill.
- XIX. Equipment must be used in the appropriate manner. Any deliberate misuse and consequential damage to equipment will result in the participant who caused the damage paying for costs incurred.
- XX. You must complete every challenge correctly before moving on to the next challenge. Each competitor will need to run back to their team to tag the next person so they can start the next challenge.
- XXI. Each team will have one dedicated judge. That judge will watch every challenge you complete, record your times, and observe if the challenge has been completed correctly.
