59. **CHOCOLATE CAKE -** Iced (20cm round or square tin) not sandwich, presented on a board/base

60. **CARAMEL FINGERS** – Must use following recipe: 120g butter, 1 cup brown sugar, 1 egg beaten, 1 cup SR Flour, pinch salt, vanilla Method – Melt butter and brown sugar. Beat in egg then dry ingredients. Press into slice tray and bake in moderate oven for 30 minutes. When cool, ice with the following icing and cut into fingers, 2.5cm x 5cm. Icing – 45g butter, ½ cup brown sugar, ½ cup icing sugar, 2 tbls milk, vanilla Method – Combine butter, brown sugar and milk in a small saucepan. Cook over low heat. When mixture comes to boil remove from stove and stir in icing sugar. Add vanilla and stir.
