CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

- **All Prime Trade cattle entered for competition, must be offered for sale, if not sold, are required to pay an additional fee of \$22.00 inc GST per head (capped at \$330 inc GST per exhibitor), over and above normal entry fee. Cattle bought back by owner will have commission charged**
- The ear tags supplied by the Society are to be applied PRIOR to arrival at the Warwick Municipal Saleyards at 4pm on Thursday, 21st March 2024 and exhibit/s MUST BE accompanied by a declaration as at age (number of teeth) of the exhibit/s. STEWARDS reserve the RIGHT TO MOUTH ALL PRIZE WINNERS.
- All Cattle entered in this section must be dehorned at least one month prior to arrival at the Saleyards or they will not be eligible to compete. To avoid bruising only dehorned Cattle (polled or dehorned, not showing any regrowth in excess of 3cm with no sharp edges) are eligible to compete in this section. Cattle not meeting the above specifications will not be accepted.
- Entries must be bona-fide property of the Exhibitor at least 3 months prior to judging date.
- All entries received are subjected to the right of the Stewards to reject any Cattle not up to Show standard, and if required, to arrange for same to be removed from the grounds before judging commences.
- Stewards also retain the right to transfer any entry.
- On arrival at the grounds, all Cattle must be penned before judging commences.
- A freshly erupted tooth will be counted.
- Champions can be selected from Single or Pen Classes.
- No Cattle are allowed as non-competitive.
- All Exhibitors must remain outside the yards whilst the Cattle are being judged.
- All Cattle will be judged on Conformation, Finish, Weight for Age and Evenness of Pen.
- The Judge shall have the right to make no award in classes where he considers the entries not worthy of a prize.
- NLIS Ear tags must be affixed to all cattle.
- All Cattle to be sold must be accompanied by a current National Vendor Declaration and a Bio-Security form.
- The agent for the vendors will be responsible for verifying the chief steward, if cattle are to be entered into the crop/grass fed classes.
- In Pen Classes, age to be taken from oldest beast in Pen
- All cattle will be sold on a curfew basis.
- Entrants in the Prime Cattle section cannot be entered in any other section of the Warwick Show.
- With feeder class entries if total average weight is less than 280kg or greater than 400kg the cattle will forfeit judging but still can be included in sale.

1. **Single Vealer** – *Liveweight up to 280kg*
2. **Pen of 3 Vealers** – *Liveweight up to 280kg*
3. **Single Vealer/ Yearling (Milk or Crop Fed only)**
– *Liveweight 281kg to 400kg*
4. **Single Vealer/Yearling (Steer or Heifer, Grain Assist or Grain Fed)** – *Liveweight 281kg to 400kg*
5. **Pen of 3 Vealers or Yearling (Steer or Heifer, Grain Assist or Grain Fed)** – *Liveweight 28kg to 400kg*
6. **Single Steer or Heifer (Crop Fed Only)** – *Liveweight 401 to 500kg*
7. **Single Steer or Heifer (Crop Fed Only)** –
Liveweight 401 kg & 500kg
8. **Pen of 3 Steers or Heifers** – *Liveweight 401 kg & 500kg*
9. **Single Steer or Heifer (Crop Fed)** - showing NO MORE THAN 2 permanent teeth, 501kgs and over.
10. **Single Steer or Heifer (Grain Assist or Grain Fed)** - showing NO MORE THAN 2 permanent teeth, 501kgs & over
11. **Pen of 3 Steers or Heifers (Grain Assist or Grain Fed)** – showing NO MORE THAN 2 permanent teeth, 501kgs & over
12. **Pen of 3 Feeder Steers (Grass or Fodder Crop NO Grain Assist)** - average live weight between 300kg and 400kg.
13. **Pen of 3 Feeder Heifers (Grass or Fodder Crop NO Grain Assist)** - average live weight between 300kg and 400kg.
