GUIDELINES FOR EVENTS

VETERAN RIDERS

Veteran classes are classes for Athletes who:

- Reach their 45th birthday in the current year
- Who, in the current year, have not taken part in any competition in which the height of the obstacles for the initial round exceeds 1.30m
- Must not have competed on any horse in a class higher than 1.05m for the initial round at THIS SHOW
- Must be current EA members

Article 255 – EA Amateur Riders, Juniors, Children

1. Amateur Rider classes are classes for Athletes who:

1.1 Athletes must meet the membership requirements as set out in the EA General Regulations.

1.2 Athletes may compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age 1.3 Amateur Rider classes are classes for Athletes who:

• Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing

• In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying competition or in a 5* 3 day event/ 4* 3 day event prior to 2021.

• Must not have competed in section 1 or 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years

• Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that event.

• Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a Horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that event.

2 Juniors: Athletes can take part in Competitions for Juniors from the calendar year they turn 12 until the end of the calendar year, in which they reach the age of 18 years

2.1 Athletes may take part in open Competitions 1.20m and above from the beginning of the calendar year in which they reach the age of 12 years.

2.2 Junior Championships at State, National Championships and in Junior Championships with heights of 1.20m above in show schedules a minimum age of 12yrs applies.

2.3 A Junior Athlete may compete in Junior and Senior Competitions on the same horse at the same event in National and State Jumping Competitions, and Agricultural Shows UNLESS permission is denied in the Schedule.2.4 In Competitions with the word "Senior" in the title (Example: Senior Championship, Senior Grand Prix, Senior Six

Bar), Athletes are eligible to compete from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 18 years.

3. Children: An Athlete may compete in Children's classes from the calendar year they turn 10 until the end of the calendar year in which they turn 14 years old.

3.1 Starting height in the first round for Children's classes is a maximum of 1.05m

INFORMATION FOR THE THOROUGHBRED SPORT HORSE COMPETITOR:

The TSHA's main job is to liaise with the show societies to organise thoroughbred classes and to gain sponsorship from the Racing Industry to support these classes with substantial prize money.

- To compete in the Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association classes you must purchase a competition licence with the TSHA through Global Entries Online. The cost of the licence is \$55 per year (it goes on the calendar year from the date you pay for your licence, so every horse gets 365 days of value for money).
- TSHA conditions for the show organisers is that regardless of the amount of prize money on offer the entry fees are 10% of first prize money and capped at \$40 for the 2019/20 financial year.
- The licence can be obtained by logging into www.globalentriesonline.com.au and creating an account. You then go to the 'manage horses' page and click on the button saying "TSHA licence" and fill in the details.
- No part bred thoroughbreds or horses who do not appear in the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book will be eligible to compete in the Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association Classes.

- The Licence fee is for competition only and is not proof of ownership. The licence and the information provided help us track the horses that are competing so that the data can be passed on to the Thoroughbred Industry.
- This data will go towards the statistics for rehoming and repurposing racehorses and is a key reason for the industry sponsorship.
- The fees collected go towards the costs of running the TSHA, and any left-over funds are channelled back into prize money and rugs/ribbons/trophies

Everyone working for the TSHA does so on a voluntary basis.

To be Eligible for TSHA your thoroughbred must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book. You must provide a microchip number and the number brands.

The prize money will be paid to the winning rider. Connections of the horse must organise the prize money split, if any, between themselves.

Any horses and riders competing in the TSHA Showjumping Thoroughbred classes 1.05m and over must also hold EA registration
