Regulations

- I. All exhibitors & minors in their care are expected to follow all directives as required, the society & its representatives have the right to refuse entry.
- II. Exhibitors or persons in charge of exhibits who use offensive language & ignore directives of Judges, Stewards or Show Society will be removed from the pavilion.
- III. Entry fees must be **paid upon arrival**, no shows still pay entry fees, unless canceled before the closing date.
- IV. Gate admission applies to all exhibitors and spectators.
- V. Society or Stewards reserve the right to refuse entries.
- VI. No responsibility will be taken for loss of entries, email warwickpoultryclub@gmail.com for confirmation.
- VII. Disease or vermin infected birds are not to be penned, any bird deemed to be suffering ill health or infected with parasites will have to be removed from the pavilion.
- VIII. All care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society will not be responsible for any loss or damage. Water cups to be maintained by the exhibitors, any concerns raised with the stewards.
- IX. No entry or exit after 8:30am through the poultry shed external road door.
- X. Individual birds in breeding pens are not eligible for Open Championship Awards.
- XI. The ages of the Cockerels and Pullets must not exceed 12 months on the day of the Show.
- XII. Judging will commence at 9am on the day of the Show, Judges decision is final.
- XIII. **AOC** – This is an abbreviation of AORC and is intended to mean the same. It does not include colours outside of those listed for that breed in the current Australian Poultry Standards. **AOV** – This is an abbreviation of AORV and is intended to mean the same. It does not include breeds or varieties outside of the current Australian Poultry Standards.
- XIV. Junior Classes - Junior must pen and care for their exhibit, juniors can enter different birds into open classes.
- XV. No Exhibits are to be removed from the Pavilion before awards presentations on Saturday and must be removed only under the supervision of a Steward.
- XVI. More than 5 birds entered will have a class created for that breed/colour at the stewards discretion.

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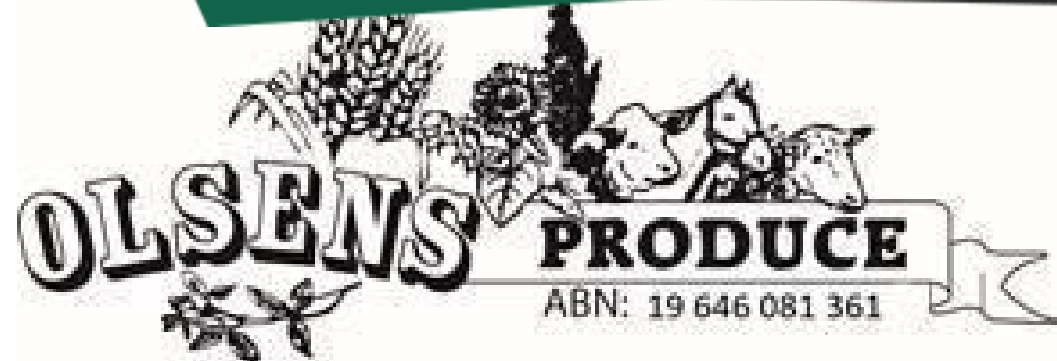


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
