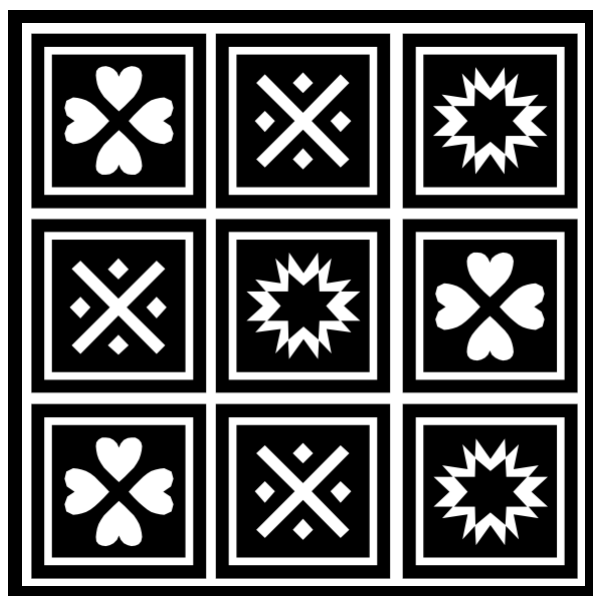

PRIZE MONEY: 1st \$10.00 2nd \$5.00 3rd Prize card (**Where sponsorship allows**)(Vouchers to the value of).

1. Entries will ONLY be accepted on payment of fees and completion of the official Needlework entry form and the GST Hobby Form.
2. An EXHIBIT is the actual article to be shown.
3. **Exhibits and Entry fees will be received at the Pavilion between 3pm and 8pm on Tuesday 19 March 2019** OR phone me to make alternative arrangements;
Entries will NOT be received at the show office.
4. Prize Money will be collected at the same time as collecting exhibits.
5. NO prize money will be posted unless the exhibitor resides 50km or more from Warwick.
6. It is the judge's decision as to whether prizes are awarded in a section or a class.
ALL exhibitors MUST abide by the judge's decision.
7. **If there are no more than three (3) entries in a class only one prize will be awarded.**
8. Cleanliness of all exhibits is essential; **exhibits must be new and unused.**
9. The exhibits must NOT have been washed (with the exception of exhibits from the spinning section) or worn.
10. The exhibit must be completely the OWN WORK of the exhibitor.
11. An ARTICLE is something NOT WORN, a GARMENT is a piece of CLOTHING.
12. **All entries must have been completed within the last two (2) years.**
13. **Exhibits must NOT** have been shown at a previous Warwick Show.
14. The committee reserves the right to reject any exhibit or exhibits which may be considered not of sufficient merit to be displayed.
15. The Steward and/or Judge reserve the right to change the class of an article or garment.
16. A Novice is someone **new to the hobby or craft in the last twelve (12) months.**
17. **Exhibits will be available for collection from 9am to 12 noon on Sunday 24 March 2019.**
This rule will be strictly observed.
No item is to be removed without the Steward's approval.
If a representative of the exhibitor collects the item a form must be filled out by the representative accepting responsibility for the item.
18. Whilst the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society Inc. accepts **NO** responsibility for missing or damaged articles, **all possible care will be taken with exhibits.**
19. All framed articles must be suitable to hang safely *or will not be accepted.*
20. All quilts are to have a 4 inch rod pocket attached for hanging, (can be securely pinned using safety pins only). **Quilts will not be accepted without rod pocket in place** whether hung or laid for display.
21. Exhibits may be sold following the judging with 15% commission payable to the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society. You must provide your own for sale sticker and price tag for the item.
22. A limit of three (3) items per class per person.
23. Names and labels on exhibits **MUST** be covered with a fabric square.

Section A ASSORTED - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- 1 Cross Stitch Picture - Picture must be framed or a finished article
- 2 Tatting - any item or decoration on a garment
- 3 Lead Lighting - small item e.g.: picture frame, candle sconce...
- 4 Mosaic - small piece e.g.: tile, pot plant ...

Section C CROCHET - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- 5 Knee rug - no larger the 100cm square or round
- 6 Table Centre, Tray Cloth or Doily any medium
- 7 I pair of Socks, Slippers, Mittens or Gloves
- 8 Scarf- any medium
- 9 Shawl or Wrap - any medium
- 10 Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section D DISABLED - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- 11 Any Item listed in schedule

Section E EMBROIDERY - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- 12 Wool Embroidery - wool embroidery on a woollen garment or article
- 13 Crewel Embroidery - any article
- 14 Any other form of embroidery - e.g. assisi, hardanger, white work ...
- 15 Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section H HISTORICAL CLOTHING - MEDIEVAL - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- 16 Handmade pre 17th Century hat or head covering, may be adorned with embroidery ,jewels or feathers

Section J JUNIOR - UNDER 16 YEARS - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- 17 Patchwork - pencil case - must have a zipper closure
- 18 Patchwork - cushion - front must be pieced and the back include a zipper closure - must have insert for display
- 19 Sewing - a dress or nighty for yourself
- 20 Sewing - T-shirt and shorts or summer pj's (top and shorts) for yourself
- 21 Sewing - a novelty item - pin cushion, covered coat hanger, cup/mug rug and warmer etc
- 22 Sewing - soft toy

Section K KNITTING - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- 23 Adult Jumper or Cardigan - wool or wool blend - any ply
- 24 Scarf - any medium
- 25 Vest - any size , any ply
- 26 Knitted Toy - any medium
- 27 1 x Pair of Socks, Gloves or Mittens
- 28 Baby rug or shawl
- 29 Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section S SEWING - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- 30 Childs Dress / Sun Frock - 4 to 8 years
- 31 Babies outfit - under 12 months - Dress, Rompers or Overalls
- 32 Adult blouse with collar and button front
- 33 Soft Toy
- 34 Novelty Item - pin cushion, coat hanger, casserole dish cover etc
- 35 Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section P PATCHWORK AND QUILTING - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- 36 Traditional Quilt - Machine Pieced - Machine Quilted - MUST have a 4" rod pocket for hanging
- 37 Traditional Quilt - Machine or Hand pieced - HAND Quilted - MUST have 4" rod Pocket for hanging
- 38 Patchwork / Quilted Table Runner or Centre
- 39 Patchwork Bag / Purse
- 40 Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section

W WEAVING, SPINNING AND FELTING- a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- 41 WOVEN Scarf from Hand spun Wool or Wool Blend
- 42 Adult Jumper or Cardigan knit or crochet from Hand spun wool or wool blend
- 43 Scarf - knit or crochet from hand spun wool or wool blend
- 44 Socks or Mittens / Gloves knit or crochet from hand spun wool or wool blend
- 45 Nuno felting - any item or garment made using the nuno felting technique
- 46 Small item using the wet felting technique - (hat, slippers, bag etc)
- 47 Skein of spun fibre with a 10cm (4") square knitted or crocheted sample - please state what the fibre is
- 48 Hand woven household article e.g.: tea towel, hand towel, mat, table runner....
- 49 Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section Z CHALLENGE - HAPPY HEXAGONS - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- 50 Something with hexagons as the main feature e.g.: bag, place mat, table centre, tray cloth.....
