### **CONDITIONS OF ENTRY**

1. NO late entries will be accepted.
2. Entries will ONLY be accepted on payment of fees and completion of the official entry form.
3. An EXHIBIT is the actual article to be shown.
4. Exhibits will be received at the Kevin Thumpkin Pavilion between 7.30am and 9.30am on Thursday 21<sup>st</sup> March 2019.
5. Prize Money MUST be collected during the Show - prize money winnings will be null and void at the end of April 2019
6. NO prize money will be posted unless the exhibitor resides 50km or more from Warwick.
7. Where there are less than three (3) entries in a class only one (1) prize will be awarded.
8. Cleanliness of all exhibits is essential.
9. The exhibit must be completely the OWN WORK of the exhibitor.
10. All entries must have been completed within the last two (2) years.
11. Exhibits must NOT have been shown at a previous Warwick Annual Show.
12. The committee reserves the right to reject any exhibit or exhibits which may be considered not of sufficient merit to be displayed.
13. All exhibitors MUST abide by the judge's decision as to whether prizes are awarded in a section or a class.
14. The Kevin Thumpkin Pavilion will be open from 10.00am to 8.00pm on Friday 22<sup>nd</sup> March 2018, 10.00am to 8.00pm Saturday 23<sup>rd</sup> March 2019.
15. **Exhibits will be available for collection from 8.00am-10.00am on Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2019.** This rule will be ***strictly*** observed. If a representative of the exhibitor collects the item a form must be filled out by the representative accepting responsibility for the item.
16. Whilst the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society Inc. accepts NO responsibility for missing or damaged articles, all possible care will be taken with exhibits.
17. All framed articles must be suitable to hang safely.
18. Any exhibits requiring a posted return will be required to supply a stamped self-addressed envelope on entry of the article/exhibit.
19. Articles/Exhibits may be sold following the judging with 15% commission payable to the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society Inc. You must provide your own for sale sticker and price tag for the item. Sold exhibits cannot be collected until Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> March 2019.
