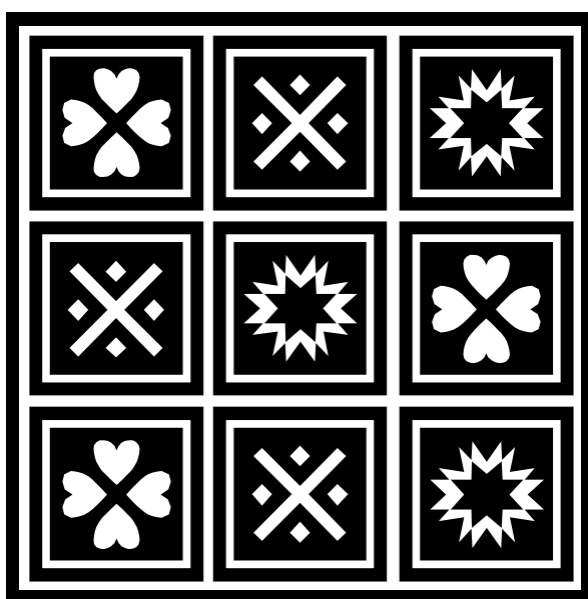

ENTRY FEE: \$1.00 per entry

PRIZE MONEY: 1st \$10.00 2nd \$5.00 3rd Prize card (**Where sponsorship allows**).

1. Entries will ONLY be accepted on payment of fees and completion of the official Needlework entry form and the GST Hobby Form.
2. An EXHIBIT is the actual article to be shown.
3. Exhibits and Entry fees will be received at the Pavilion between 3pm and 8pm on the Tuesday before the show 2020 OR phone me to make alternative arrangements;
Entries will NOT be received at the show office.
4. Prize Money will be collected at the same time as collecting exhibits.
5. NO prize money will be posted unless the exhibitor resides 50km or more from Warwick.
6. It is the judge's decision as to whether prizes are awarded in a section or a class.
ALL exhibitors MUST abide by the judge's decision.
7. ***If there are no more than three (3) entries in a class only one prize will be awarded.***
8. Cleanliness of all exhibits is essential; ***exhibits must be new and unused.***
9. The exhibits must NOT have been washed (with the exception of exhibits from the spinning section) or worn.
10. The exhibit must be completely the OWN WORK of the exhibitor, with the exception for professionally quilted quilts.
11. An ARTICLE is something NOT WORN, a GARMENT is a piece of CLOTHING.
12. ***All entries must have been completed within the last two (2) years.***
13. ***Exhibits must NOT*** have been shown at a previous Warwick Show.
14. The committee reserves the right to reject any exhibit or exhibits which may be considered not of sufficient merit to be displayed.
15. The Steward and/or Judge reserve the right to change the class of an article or garment.
16. A Novice is someone ***new to the hobby or craft in the last twelve (12) months.***
17. ***Exhibits will be available for collection from 9am to 12 noon on Sunday 24 March 2020.***
This rule will be strictly observed.
No item is to be removed without the Steward's approval.
If a representative of the exhibitor collects the item a form must be filled out by the representative accepting responsibility for the item.
18. Whilst the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society Inc. accepts **NO** responsibility for missing or damaged articles, ***all possible care will be taken with exhibits.***
19. All framed articles must be suitable to hang safely *or will not be accepted.*
20. All quilts are to have a 4 inch rod pocket attached for hanging, (can be securely pinned using safety pins only).
Quilts will not be accepted without rod pocket in place whether hung or laid for display.
21. Exhibits may be sold following the judging with 15% commission payable to the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society. You must provide your own for sale sticker and price tag for the item.
22. A limit of three (3) items per class per person.
23. Names and labels on exhibits **MUST** be covered with a fabric square.
24. Many hours work go into preparing the schedule for you to take home on Sunday morning with your exhibits. Some classes will change, some will stay the same. I am always open to suggestions for different classes. This gives you a full 12 months to work on your entries **as per the schedule** for the following year's show. Entries that do not fit a class will be displayed only.

| Section A | ASSORTED - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class |
| Class 1 | Cross Stitch Picture - Picture must be framed or a finished article |
| Class 2 | Tatting - Needle or Shuttle - any item or decoration on a garment |
| Class 3 | Mosaic - small piece eg: tile, pot plant ... |
| Class 4 | Latch Hook - cushion or wall hanging - Cushion to have insert, wall hanging ready to hang. |
| Section C | CROCHET - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class |
| Class 5 | Knee rug - no larger the 100cm square or round |
| Class 6 | Table Centre, Tray Cloth or Doiley any medium |
| Class 7 | I pair of Socks, Slippers, Mittens or Gloves |
| Class 8 | Scarf- any medium |
| Class 9 | Shawl or Wrap - any medium |
| Class 10 | Amigarumi - toy or animal - any medium |
| Class 11 | Novice - any entry in any of the above categories |
| Section D | DISABLED - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class |
| Class 12 | Any Item listed in schedule |
| Section E | EMBROIDERY - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class |
| Class 13 | Wool Embroidery - wool embroidery on a woollen garment or article |
| Class 14 | Crewel Embroidery - any article |
| Class 15 | Any other form of embroidery - eg assisi, hardanger, white work ... |
| Class 16 | Novice - any entry in any of the above categories |
| Section F | FELTING |
| Class 17 | Needle Felting - article or garment decorated or made with the needle felting technique |
| Class 18 | Nuno felting - any item or garment made using the nuno felting tchnique |
| Class 19 | Small item using the wet felting technique - (hat, slippers, bag etc) |
| Section H | HISTORICAL CLOTHING - MEDIEVAL - PRE 17TH CENTURY |
| Class 20 | Renaissance Venetian Mask - paper mache, decorated with traditional materials - no plastics or glitter. |
| Class21 | Cloak or Cape - using pre 17th century patterns and materials. |
| Section J | JUNIOR - UNDER 16 YEARS - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class |
| Class 22 | Patchwork - pencil case - must have a zipper closure |
| Class 23 | Patchwork - cushion - front pieced and the back include a zipper, NOT buttons - must have insert |
| Class 24 | Sewing - a dress or nighty for yourself |
| Class 25 | Sewing - T-shirt and shorts or summer pj's (top and shorts) for yourself |
| Class 26 | Sewing - a novelty item - pin cushion, covered coathanger, cup/mug rug and warmer etc |
| Class 27 | Sewing - soft toy |
| Section K | KNITTING - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class |
| Class 28 | Adult Jumper or Cardigan - wool or wool blend - any ply |
| Class 29 | Scarf - any medium |
| Class 30 | Vest - any size , any ply |
| Class 31 | Knitted Toy - any medium |
| Class 32 | 1 x Pair of Socks, Gloves or Mittens |
| Class 33 | Baby rug or shawl |
| Class 34 | Novice - any entry in any of the above categories |

Section S SEWING - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- Class 35 Childs Dress / Sun Frock - 4 to 8 years
- Class 36 Babies outfit - under 12 months - Dress, Rompers or Overalls
- Class 37 Adult blouse with collar and button front
- Class 38 Soft Toy
- Class 39 Novelty Item - pin cushion, coat hanger, caserole dish cover etc
- Class 40 Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section SP SPINNING - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- Class 41 WOVEN Scarf using hand spun fibre
- class 42 Adult Jumper, Cardigan or Jacket using hand spun fibre
- Class 43 Scarf, Shawl or Wrap, knit or crochet, using hand spun fibre.
- Class 44 Socks or Mittens, Gloves, Cap or Beanie - knit or crochet using hand spun fibre
- Class 45 Skein of spun fibre, with a 10cm (4") square knit crocher or woven sample. Please state what the fibre is.

Section P PATCHWORK AND QUILTING - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- Class 46 Traditional Quilt - Machine Pieced - Machine Quilted - MUST have a 4" rod pocket for hanging
- Class 47 Traditional Quilt - Machine or Hand pieced - HAND Quilted - MUST have 4" rod Pocket for hanging
- Class 48 Patchwork / Quilted Table Runner or Centre
- Class 49 Patchwork Bag / Purse
- Class 50 Novice - any entry in any of the above categories

Section SN SENIORS - Display by Seniors

Section SP SPINNING - a limit of three (3) entries per person per class

- Class 51 WOVEN Scarf using hand spun fibre
- Class 52 Adult Jumper, Cardigan or Jacket using hand spun fibre
- Class 53 Scarf, Shawl or Wrap, knit or crochet, using hand spun fibre.
- Class 54 Socks or Mittens, Gloves, Cap or Beanie - knit or crochet using hand spun fibre
- Class 55 Skein of spun fibre, with a 10cm (4") square knit crocher or woven sample. Please state what the fibre is.

Section W WEAVING - SPONSORED by WARWICK SPINNERS and WEAVERS

- Class 56 Hand Woven Garment - any type of fibre

- Class 57 Make something new from old jeans.
