Conditions:

1. Classes 1 – 6 to be displayed in a clear 500g round glass jar with a white lid.
2. Class 7 to be displayed in a white painted wooden frame with clear glass sides.

4. In classes, if more than 1 entry, a Champion will be awarded.
5. Prize money – all classes – 1st - \$15 e-voucher donated by Nuplas, 2nd - \$10 and 3rd - \$5
