All placegetters MUST present for prizes mounted, or prizemoney is forfeited

All nomination must be done through the showjumping office on the day

Competitors compete at their own risk. All riders must wear helmets that comply with EA Helmet standards.

Horses may only enter in **maximum of 2 classes per day and only 1 Championship Class**

A horse/rider combination may enter only one part of a combined class.

Classes 8, 9 & 10 will be run in conjunction – **one** class per horse

Where there are less than 10 entries in any class, the organising committee reserves the right to combine or cancel the class.

The organising committee reserves the right to change prizes/prizemoney

All riders competing at the event will be expected to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry, and must sign a waiver form in the office before competing

The Organising Committee reserves the right to swab horses. Random swabbing of horses may be conducted in any official class. Horses chosen for swabbing must proceed directly to the swabbing box immediately after the presentation.

INTERSCHOOL RIDERS – Due to new rules from the Interschool Committee, IQ tag ons may only have 1 class per height for the whole event as a tag on, therefore only events marked with a * are eligible to be used as an Interschool Qualifier. Riders **MUST** complete the Interschool Tag on Form stating which events that they are competing in for qualification.

OTT/THOROUGHBRED SERIES RIDERS – **MUST** complete the Tag on Form stating which events that they are competing in for qualification.

YOU MUST KNOW YOUR TSHA COMPETITION LICENCE Number when you nominate or you will not be permitted to enter in the TSHA classes (read the conditions at the end of the program to find out where you can purchase this licence)

GUIDELINES FOR EVENTS

INFORMATION FOR THE THOROUGHBRED SPORT HORSE COMPETITOR:

The TSHA's main job is to liaise with the show societies to organise thoroughbred classes and to gain sponsorship from the Racing Industry to support these classes with substantial prize money.

- To compete in the Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association classes – you must purchase a competition licence with the TSHA through Global Entries Online. The cost of the licence is \$55 per year (it goes on the calendar year from the date you pay for your licence, so every horse gets 365 days of value for money).
- TSHA conditions for the show organisers is that regardless of the amount of prize money on offer – the entry fees are 10% of first prize money and capped at \$40 for the 2019/20 financial year.
- The licence can be obtained by logging into www.globalentriesonline.com.au and creating an account. You then go to the 'manage horses' page – and click on the button saying "TSHA licence" and fill in the details.
- No part bred thoroughbreds or horses who do not appear in the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book will be eligible to compete in the Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association Classes.
- The Licence fee is for competition only – and is not proof of ownership. The licence and the information provided help us track the horses that are competing so that the data can be passed on to the Thoroughbred Industry.
- This data will go towards the statistics for rehoming and repurposing racehorses and is a key reason for the industry sponsorship.
- The fees collected go towards the costs of running the TSHA, and any left-over funds are channelled back into prize money and rugs/ribbons/trophies

Everyone working for the TSHA does so on a voluntary basis.

To be Eligible for TSHA your thoroughbred must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book.

You must provide a microchip number and the number brands.

The prize money will be paid to the winning rider. Connections of the horse must organise the prize money split, if any, between themselves.

Any horses and riders competing in the TSHA Showjumping Thoroughbred classes 1.05m and over must also hold EA registration

VETERAN RIDERS

Veteran classes are classes for Athletes who:

- Reach their 45th birthday in the current year
- Who, in the current year, have not taken part in any competition in which the height of the obstacles for the initial round exceeds 1.30m
- Must not have competed on any horse in a class higher than 1.05m for the initial round at THIS SHOW
- Must be current EA members

This event is part of a series with Dalby Show.

Highest points for horse/rider combination from 2 rounds of series (Class 17b at Warwick Show) and (Class 2102 at Dalby Show) will receive \$200 and a rug.

A Shield with the winner's name engraved will be retained by Dalby & District Show Society

Article 255 – Amateur Riders

1. Amateur Rider classes are classes for Athletes who:

- Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing
- In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round.
- Must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide or Perth in the past two years
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.

- 1.1 Athletes must meet the membership requirements as set out in the EA General Regulations.
- 1.2 Athletes may compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age.
- 1.3 Organisers may at their discretion limit the number of horses a rider can start.
- 1.4 The course shall be free-flowing and relatively simple. The first obstacle in the first round should be 10cm lower than the advertised starting height of the competition.
- 1.5 There will be a maximum height rise of 10cm for the jump-off.

GUIDELINES FOR GREG GRANT UP & COMING SERIES

- Horses must be EA Registered
- Horses must be in their 1st or 2nd year of EA registration
- Horses must be owner ridden or leased
- Courses will be set at 1.05m maximum height in the first round, 1st fence to be no higher than 95cm (Second Round 1.10m max)
- Classes are run under Article 238.2.2
- All placegetters and double clear rounds will be eligible to compete in the finals at the end of the year
- A Greg Grant Saddlery Up & Coming Rug will be presented to the winner of each class. Prize money to 6th place

Qld Racing and Dalby and Northern Downs Jockey Club Off the Track (OTT)/Thoroughbred 5 Track Series

Competition for Registered Studbook Thoroughbreds to compete across 5 events and qualify for Final in Dalby 18th April 2020

Two Sections:

1. **OTT/Thoroughbred (Off the Record)** - Registered Studbook Thoroughbred, Raced, Trialled, unraced. Do not have to be EA registered (Competition 80-100 cm)
2. **OTT/Thoroughbred (On the Record)** - Registered Studbook Thoroughbred that have Raced, Trialled, unraced that are EA Registered (competition will be 1.05 cm - 120 cm) This class is designed for horses of any age that have not yet jumped official in 1.05 cm classes or above. We will be running this as an honour system. Any horse to be found to have competed in an official class prior to the first series event (Australia Day Showjumping) will be disqualified from the series.

RULES

- Riders must be EA or PC current 2020 Financial members
- Studbook/Life Numbers to check validation
- Both Off the Record and On the Record have raced trialled or unraced and can be any age
- Horses competing in On the Record Section must have EA registration
- Horse/rider combination can move between the heights but not on the same day.
- Horse/rider combinations can qualify for both classes but MUST compete at the higher height that the horse rider combination has qualified in the final
- Horses will be eligible to compete in the final if they place 1st to 5th in an of the qualifying classes at the following events

25th /26th Jan 2020 Australia Day Showjumping

29th Feb/1st March 2020 Millmerran Show

20th-22nd March 2020 Warwick Show

10th-12th April 2020 Darling Downs Showjumping Pittsworth

17th April 2020 Dalby Show
