Miss Warwick Showgirl & Rural Ambassador Competition 2020

Information for All Entrants

The Warwick Show and Rodeo Society thanks you for your interest in the 2020 Showgirl & Rural Ambassador competition. The competition is an excellent opportunity for young men & women to become involved in the local show and community. The aim of the competition is to broaden the knowledge and participation of our youth in the Show Movement and in return for them to learn lifelong skills and gain personal development.

Ladies aged between 12 to 28 are eligible to enter the Showgirl competition, and both men & women aged between 15 to 30 are eligible to enter the Rural Ambassador competition, subject to the conditions listed in the Conditions of Entry form.

All entrants are encouraged to fundraise, however it is not a requirement. Monies fundraised will go towards the development and improvement of facilities at the Warwick Showgrounds. There will be an overall fundraiser prize for the person who has raised the most funds throughout the quest.

All competition titles, Junior Showgirl, Teen Showgirl, Miss Warwick Showgirl, Junior Rural Ambassador and Rural Ambassador & Overall Fundraiser will be crowned at the Warwick Showball & Presentation Evening on Saturday 29th February 2020.

What to Expect on Judging Day

All entrants of the Showgirl & Rural Ambassador competition will be judged by a panel of three (3) judges and once the winners and title holders have been announced, they will remain in that title until the next year's Showgirl & Rural Ambassador competition. Entrants are judged on personality, confidence, ambition and life goals, general knowledge, show knowledge, presentation and speech. Contestants are also asked to demonstrate knowledge of their local community. The competition provides an opportunity to excel in leadership, community involvement, self-management and confidence. Dress code for judging is normally Smart Day Wear (i.e. shirt & skirt/dress pants/moleskins; and or smart casual dress) and Evening Dress (i.e. cocktail dress, suit coat & tie) for the presentation dinner.

The Warwick Show Society is a member of the Darling Downs Sub-Chamber (one of 11 Sub-Chambers throughout Queensland). Our Showgirl & Rural Ambassador winners will then go on to compete at the Darling Downs Sub-Chamber finals which are held at the Toowoomba Royal Show. This competition involves a private judging interview with a panel of judges and a public function such as a lunch or dinner and onstage interview and questions. The winning Sub-Chamber Finalist will then go onto the State Final which is held during the Brisbane Royal Show (Ekka) in August. The State Final is organised by the State Showgirl Committee.

What to Expect During the Show

The Showgirl & Rural Ambassador winners will perform various tasks which could include opening a Show, public speaking throughout the year, presenting prizes to winners at show events, attending local events as a representative of the Warwick Show & Rodeo Society, assisting in organising the next Showgirl & Rural Ambassador competition and encouraging future entrants by speaking with potential candidates.

All entrants are expected to attend each day of the Warwick Show from Friday 20 March to Sunday 22 March 2020. You will mingle with the crowd, wander through all sections, attend award presentations for different sections of the show and of course enjoy yourselves.

Entrants will also have the opportunity to be in the spotlight over the weekend with reporters from the local newspapers as well as radio stations where you will be able to promote our local Show.

FUNDRAISING IDEAS

All entrants are encouraged to fundraise, however it is not a requirement. Monies fundraised will go towards the development and improvement of facilities at the Warwick Showgrounds. There will be an overall fundraiser prize for the person who has raised the most funds throughout the quest.

The use of facilities at the Warwick Showgrounds are available to entrants of the Miss Warwick Showgirl & Rural Ambassador competition free of charge for their fundraising events if they require it.
