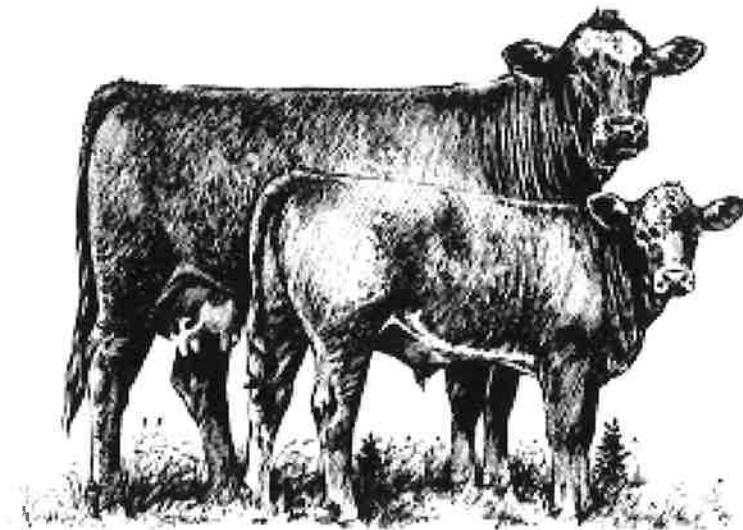

## **ACCEPTANCE OF ENTRIES**

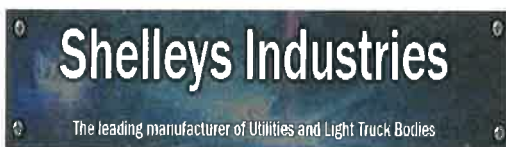
The attention of intending Exhibitors is drawn to the fact that entries are accepted subject to the Rules and the Constitution of this Society, in addition to the Special Regulations which appear within this schedule.

## **REGULATIONS & CONDITIONS**

1. All cattle entered throughout this Section must be registered with their respective Breed Society, with the exception of entries in the led steer/heifer classes.
2. Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society will not be responsible for any losses, deaths, or accidents to stock.
3. **Bedding will NOT be provided. Exhibitors are required to provide their own bedding and feed.**
4. Ages of cattle entered for competition shall be taken as at **1st March 2020**.
5. Calves to be entered in a single class or with mother only.
6. Stud heifers are not eligible to participate in the led steer/heifer classes.
7. If doubt should arise in the mind of the judge, in any Class, as to the classification of a competing animal, the matter will be referred to the Stewards of the particular sub section for consideration.
8. All cattle to be the bona-fide property of the Exhibitor.
9. All cattle under 6 months must be led by a halter. **All cattle over 6 months MUST be led by a halter and nose ring/grip. Bulls over 10 months MUST have a nose ring.**
10. It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that the leaders of their stock in judging rings and paraders are capable of exercising control over the animals in their care.
11. All stalled cattle must be secured with neck collars and halters.
12. **All animals must have NLIS identification.**
13. **A copy of your waybill must be handed to the Steward when cattle NLIS are scanned.**
14. All exhibitors to have Public Liability Insurance and to have same endorsed for traveling to Shows.
15. Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be required to ensure that such equipment is fitted with residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licensed electrical contractor and currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and power boards must be tested and tagged.
16. Stewards have the right to remove any animal from the Judging Ring if that animal is a danger to the safety of the public.
17. No drug, hormone or tranquillizer shall be administered to any animal except under the direction of the Society's Veterinary Surgeon whom will advise the Stewards.
18. All cattle must comply with health requirements as stipulated by Biosecurity Queensland.

Can all exhibitors please have the Biosecurity Health Declaration attached to the end of this schedule printed and completed. This can be submitted when putting in your entries, or handed to Chief Steward once at the Showgrounds. This is a mandatory requirement and must be completed.

**I AGREE TO ENSURE THAT PRIOR TO ARRIVAL:**

- All animals will be shampooed and/or cleaned, rinsed and allowed to dry, and their hooves/legs/feet will have been picked clean of all solid material and washed with shampoo.
- All vehicles and equipment accompanying the animals will be cleaned to remove all solid material that could contain disease agents, and then disinfected.

**I FURTHER DECLARE THAT:**

- The information contained in this Biosecurity Declaration and Movement Record is true and correct to the best of my knowledge.
- I agree to abide by all conditions that may be imposed at any time by the Event Organising Committee/Manager. I also agree to abide by and accept the regulations as printed in the schedule and make these entries subject to such regulations and rules of the committee.
- I acknowledge that in failure to comply, I may be directed to leave and my nominations will be forfeited.
- I acknowledge that decontamination and disinfection procedures may be required of me if instructed by the Event Organising Committee/Manager.
- All animals described above are free of cattle ticks before entering the event.
- I acknowledge that the animals above are from a JOHNE'S DISEASE FREE herd/flock.
- I acknowledge the above mentioned animals to the best of my knowledge are free from any other notifiable diseases.
