Regulations & Conditions

- **Can all exhibitors please have the Biosecurity Health Declaration printed and completed. This can be submitted when putting in your entries, or handed to Chief Steward once at the Showgrounds. This is a mandatory requirement.**
 - All cattle entered throughout this Section must be registered with their respective Breed Society, with the exception entries in the led steer/heifer classes.
 - Every care will be taken of exhibits, but the Society will not be responsible for any losses, deaths or accidents to stock.
 - **Bedding will not be provided.** Exhibitors are required to provide their own bedding and feed.
 - **Please be aware due to Covid requirements this year, a camping site fee of \$15 will be applicable for each exhibitor staying overnight due to cleaning requirements.**
 - **Ages of cattle** entered for competition shall be taken as at 1st March, 2021
 - Calves to be entered in a single class or with mother only.
 - Stud heifers are not eligible to participate in the led steer/heifer classes.
 - If doubt should arise in the mind of the judge, in any Class, as to the classification of a competing animal, the matter will be referred to the Stewards of the particular sub section for consideration.
 - All cattle to be the bona-fide property of the Exhibitor.
 - All cattle under 6 months must be led by a halter. **All cattle over 6 months MUST be led by a halter and nose ring. Bulls over 10 months MUST have a nose ring.**
 - It is the responsibility of each exhibitor to ensure that the leaders of their stock in judging rings and paraders are capable of exercising control over the animals in their care.
 - All stalled cattle must be secured with neck collars and halters.
 - **All animals must have NLIS identification.**
 - **A copy of your waybill must be handed to the Steward when cattle NLIS are scanned.**
 - All exhibitors to have Public Liability Insurance and to have some endorsed for travelling to Shows.
 - Any exhibitors/competitors intending to bring electrical equipment to the Showgrounds will be require to ensure the equipment is fitted with residual current protection and that all electrical leads, tools and appliances have been inspected by a licenced electrical contractor and currently tagged. The use of double adaptors is prohibited and power boards must be tested and tagged.
 - Stewards have the right to remove any animal from the Judging Ring if the animal is a danger to the safety of the public
 - No drug, hormone or tranquillizer shall be administered to any animal except under the direction of the Society's Veterinary Surgeon whom will advise the Stewards.
 - All cattle must comply with the health requirements as stipulated by Biosecurity Queensland.
