- A \$50 non-refundable nomination must be paid prior to closing date. In the event of a rainout prior to cars entering the arena all nomination fees will be refunded.
- All vehicles must be on grounds to be inspected at 5pm on Friday 18th March 2022. Entry gate closes at 6.30pm. Inspection of fit out can be arranged by contacting the Show Office on 07 4661 9060.
- Waiver and Release of Liability form must be signed by driver at the time of the payment of \$50 nomination fee. Failure to sign and complete waiver will result in exclusion from event.

The entrant, competitors, and any other person connected shall have no claim against the Warwick Show and Rodeo Society Inc or any other officials, servants or other person appointed by or acting for and on behalf of the said Warwick Show and Rodeo Society Inc, or in any way connected with the contest, for any injuries suffered by himself/herself, or if any other person in respect of the vehicles entered, whether or not the same shall be caused or contributed to by an act, omission or negligence on the part of the Warwick Show and Rodeo Society Inc or the respective committee thereof or any official, servant or person aforesaid, or by any defect in the circuit or course over which the event will take place. Every entrant or occupant taking part therein and the officials, servants and person therein jointly and each severally shall be indemnified against any claim or any entrant or any other person whatsoever for any injuries or damage caused by his vehicle arising out of the participating of that vehicle in such meeting.

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All drivers must be 17 years of age or over and must hold a current driver's licence or 18+ card. Proof of age may be required.
2. All cars are to be of average sedan size, eg. Holden, Falcon, Valiant, Panel Vans and Utes are allowed. HQ, HJ, HX, HZ & WB Utes and Panel Vans are excluded.
3. The vehicle must be at its original height. No alteration to the suspension is permitted.
4. All vehicles to be fitted with standard wheels and tyres. 4 x 4 tyres will not be allowed. Mudguards and bonnet must be attached and have one only 12 volt battery. The battery must be secured down nearest to centre of vehicle using metal strap or chain bolted to the floor, plastic type battery clamps will not be allowed.
5. Battery boxes may be used but battery must still be bolted down as stated above.
6. Battery must be securely wrapped using rubber material, terminals only may be exposed.
7. No internal or external reinforcement allowed except as stated.
8. A substantial roll cage and head rest is preferred but not essential with drivers seat strengthened with a support bar behind it going from floor to roof, a bar between B pillars may be used as well.
9. Cars can have a hip bar fitted between the driver's door. It is or preferable the driver's door be filled with concrete.
10. Driver's door must be painted a bright colour (separate to main vehicle colour) with a large yellow cross.
11. All doors to be chained shut with a reasonably strong chain and 50mm square mesh must be secured over the driver's side windscreen and driver's side door. Wire or rope is not acceptable. Welding the doors shut is not acceptable. A 50mm x 10mm metal strip may be welded at door latch location, chains must also be used.

12. All glass, chrome, mudflaps, badges and plastic strips are to be removed. All internal door cards carpet roof lining must be removed. Drivers' door card is to remain. An internal rear vision mirror is allowed. Original bumper bars are to be used. Bumpers do not have to be fitted.
13. Seat belts must be in good condition. Full face helmets, full cotton overalls, leather gloves, leather boots or shoes and safety glasses **MUST BE WORN**.
14. The vehicle must contain no rust in the seat and seat belt mountings or main structure of vehicle.
15. A limit of 10 litres of petrol only must be carried.
16. A boat tank or tank of similar construction of no larger than 20 litres for the fuel must be fastened to the centre rear of the vehicle. A tank breather must be fitted to the top of tank and wrap around tank at least 2 times and exit through the floor.
17. A fuel line of original size and length must be used.
18. The original fuel tank must be punctured in the bottom most area or preferably removed. Fuel filler cap must also be removed.
19. The tow tongue must be removed and overhang where it is bolted is to be cut back if it is protruding.
20. The radiator must be in the original position but fan blades are to be removed. Radiator may be removed completely.
21. All drivers must remain in their vehicles until the event is complete.
22. Any vehicle deliberately ramming the driver's door of another vehicle will be disqualified.
23. No one is permitted to deliberately hit a vehicle out of bounds or one that is disabled or surrendered.
24. Any vehicle whose engine has stopped or the vehicle has not moved more than three metres in a two minute period will be classed as being out of the event.
25. Drivers are allowed to use first and reverse gears only and travel 40 metres maximum at any one time in a straight line. Failure to abide by this will result in disqualification.
26. No driver under the influence of alcohol will be allowed to compete in the event. Random breath testing will take place. No changing drivers after breath testing.

27. All drivers are to remove their derby cars immediately after the event or a fifty dollar (\$50.00) fine will be imposed.
28. The judges' decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
29. The judges reserve the right to disqualify any driver at any time, including anyone associated with a vehicle attempting to influence the judges' decision.
30. No passengers will be allowed in any vehicles.
31. All cars must carry a coloured flag (except red) which must be raised if you are unable to continue in event.
32. All drivers must carry one bright red flag on a 1 metre pole beside them while participating. This flag is for safety reasons and will be explained at the driver's meeting on the night.
33. The vehicle's number must be displayed on the vehicle roof on a stand, minimum size 60cm x 60cm. This number is issued by the show office.
34. The scrutineer can approve or disapprove an entrant at his/her discretion. Threatening or harassing the scrutineer or any official will not help you, you will be disqualified from entering the event.
35. The Warwick Show and Rodeo Society Inc reserves the right to refuse anyone entry into the event.
