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## CONDITIONS FOR ENTRY

- All work is to be that of the individual.
- **Label back of entry:** student's name, class, school, teacher's signature or School Stamp. Student's first name may be on the front. (*check your student's information with regards to their privacy needs*)
- Entries judged as the best five for each class at the School. Only send best 5 – no class sets please.
- \*Prep - unlimited entries, size and artwork type can be anything as long as it can be pinned to a board – this year Warwick Show Committee prefer **"Australiana"** themed art.
- Prizes & entries are to be collected at Warwick Central school the week after Show.
- Grade 1 & Grade 6 - A3 sized paper or card only.
- **Please do not add extra paper or cardboard frames that exceed A4.** This will assist us in displaying each item quickly & attractively. If entries are wrong size and/or orientation they will not be considered for judging (A3 size for Grade 1 & 6 ONLY)
- **Please note the orientation & paper size for each year level – landscape or portrait.**
- Handwriting should be on the lines appropriate for the year level.
- The Judge's decision is FINAL.
- PRIZES will be awarded. All place getters will receive a certificate.

## PREP & SPECIAL EDUCATION

A non-competitive display. Art/craft work based on some aspect of the Show.

This section may have unlimited entries, however they may not all be displayed.

The overall Warwick Show theme this year is “**Australiana**” – try making artwork out of recycled materials 😊

Art work can be (but limited to) farm animals, food, clothing – as long as it can be pinned to a board.

## YEAR ONE

Paper Size – A3

Orientation - Landscape

Illustration, any medium (on A3 paper) on the theme, ‘**Living in Australia**’ (teacher may label the artwork)

## YEAR TWO

Paper Size – A4

Orientation - Landscape

Hand titled by the student (not teacher) on Year 2 lines, illustration, any medium (A4) on theme ‘**Australia is a great country because \_\_\_\_\_**’ (student/class can think of ideas e.g. bamboo, keep-cups, canvas bags, solar energy etc. anything).

## YEAR THREE

Paper Size – A4

Orientation - Landscape

Illustration, title and one (1) sentence, on Year 3 lines, about the illustration, any medium (A4) on the theme, “**Living is Australia is awesome because \_\_\_\_\_**”

Class can think of different ideas together or as individuals.

## YEAR FOUR

Paper Size – A4

Orientation - Portrait

Handwritten copy and illustration of an acrostic poem entitled “**Australiana**” on A4 page **WITH** illustration relating to text. **Cursive** handwriting is preferred.

Judges will consider accuracy (cursive handwriting, spelling and punctuation), neatness and the impact of the illustration.

## YEAR FIVE

Paper Size – A4

Orientation – Portrait

**A small report/dot points/facts on an Australian Big Thing** entitled “**...(name of big thing)..**” with a sub-title of where it is. Provide an illustration and a small map. (A4 Portrait) **E.g. The Big Pineapple, Sunshine Coast, Queensland.**

\*teacher can google ideas with students.

Where is it? What is it? When was it made? Other interesting things. Only need 5-10 facts/dot points

**\*Cursive handwriting is preferred.**

Judges will consider accuracy (cursive handwriting, spelling and punctuation), neatness and the impact of the illustration.



## YEAR SIX

Paper Size – A3

Orientation – Portrait

**Poster** on A3 paper to reflect the theme – “Australiana” Any medium (e.g. paint, pastel, pencil, collage, felt pen) – by hand.

To include the title – ‘**Australiana**’

Include a sub-title on your specific Australian topic

\*Completed poster no bigger than A3 (for display purposes).

This topic **could be (but not restricted to)** interpreted in many ways:

- ❖ What is unique and special about living in Australia
- ❖ What do we export to other countries
- ❖ What is Australia well-known for (clean beaches, farming, agriculture)
- ❖ Famous Australian movies/cinema/television
- ❖ Famous Australian products e.g. vegemite
- ❖ Why YOU (the student) love living in Australia
- ❖ Be risky! Write a project on what we could do better and make Australia a better place – these will be displayed, so maybe keep the criticism “pro-active”

**Portrait Posters should be eye-catching and the message should be easy to understand. Sometimes, less is more!**
