House Rules

Where there are less than 10 entries in any class, the organising committee reserves the right to combine or cancel the class

The organising committee reserves the right to change prizes/prizemoney

All riders competing at the event will be expected to have read and accepted the Conditions of Entry, and must sign a waiver form in the office before competing

The Organising Committee reserves the right to swab horses. Random swabbing of horses may be conducted in any official class. Horses chosen for swabbing must proceed directly to the swabbing box immediately after the presentation

GUIDELINES FOR EVENTS

VETERAN RIDERS

Veteran classes are classes for Athletes who:

- Reach their 45th birthday in the current year
- Who, in the current year, have not taken part in any competition in which the height of the obstacles for the initial round exceeds 1.30m
- Must not have competed on any horse in a class higher than 1.05m for the initial round at THIS SHOW
- Must be current EA members

This event is part of a series with Dalby Show

Highest points for horse/rider combination from 2 rounds of series (Class 25b at Warwick Show) and (Class 14a at Dalby Show) will receive a rug & \$200.00

A Shield with the winner's name engraved will be retained by Dalby & District Show Society

ARTICLE 255 – AMATEUR RIDERS

Amateur Rider classes are classes for Athletes who:

- Must not have competed in an Olympic Games or World Equestrian Games in either Jumping or Eventing
- In the past 10 years must not have competed in a World Cup for Jumping Riders qualifying round.
- Must not have competed in section 1 and 2 at a Royal Show in Sydney, Brisbane, Melbourne, Adelaide, or Perth in the past two years
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class if they compete in a class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.
- Amateur Riders may not compete in an Amateur class on a horse that will compete in any class where the first round is higher than 1.20m at that show.
 - 1.1 Athletes must meet the membership requirements as set out in the EA General Regulations.
 - 1.2 Athletes may compete as amateurs from the beginning of the calendar year in which they turn 21 years of age.
 - 1.3 Organisers may at their discretion limit the number of horses a rider can start.
 - 1.4 The course shall be free-flowing and relatively simple. The first obstacle in the first round should be 10cm lower than the advertised starting height of the competition.
 - 1.5 There will be a maximum height rise of 10cm for the jump-off.

GREG GRANT SADDLERY UP & COMING SERIES GUIDELINES UPDATED

The Greg Grant Saddlery Up & Coming Series is designed to provide competitions that promote the development of up and coming and/or young jumping horses in Australia.

GUIDELINES FOR THE SERIES:

- * Horses must be EA Life Registered.
- * Horses must be in their first or second year of EA Full Life Horse Registration (based on calendar year): i.e., 2021 or 2022. FOR THE 2022 SERIES ONLY, HORSES THAT WERE EA FULL LIFE REGISTERED IN 2020 WILL ALSO BE ELIGIBLE.
- * Horses must be owner ridden or leased.
- * Rounds will be set at 1.05 maximum height in the first round, 1st fence to be no higher than 95cm (Second Round 1.10m max)
- * Classes are run under Article 238.2.2.
- * All placegetters and double clear rounds will be eligible to compete in the finals at the end of the year.
- * A Greg Grant Saddlery Series Rug will be presented to the winner of each class. Prize money to 6th place.
- * Horses must have 16 points and under to be eligible to compete

INFORMATION FOR THE THOROUGHBRED SPORT HORSE COMPETITOR:

The TSHA's main job is to liaise with the show societies to organise thoroughbred classes and to gain sponsorship from the Racing Industry to support these classes with substantial prize money.

- To compete in the Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association classes – you must purchase a competition licence with the TSHA through Global Entries Online. The cost of the licence is \$55 per year (it goes on the calendar year from the date you pay for your licence, so every horse gets 365 days of value for money).
 - TSHA conditions for the show organisers is that regardless of the amount of prize money on offer – the entry fees are 10% of first prize money and capped at \$40 for the 2019/20 financial year.
 - The licence can be obtained by logging into www.globalentriesonline.com.au and creating an account. You then go to the 'manage horses' page – and click on the button saying "TSHA licence" and fill in the details.

- No part bred thoroughbreds or horses who do not appear in the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book will be eligible to compete in the Thoroughbred Sport Horse Association Classes.
 - The Licence fee is for competition only – and is not proof of ownership. The licence and the information provided help us track the horses that are competing so that the data can be passed on to the Thoroughbred Industry.
 - This data will go towards the statistics for rehoming and repurposing racehorses and is a key reason for the industry sponsorship.
 - The fees collected go towards the costs of running the TSHA, and any left-over funds are channelled back into prize money and rugs/ribbons/trophies

Everyone working for the TSHA does so on a voluntary basis.

To be Eligible for TSHA your thoroughbred must be registered with the Australian Thoroughbred Stud Book.

You must provide a microchip number and the number brands.

The prize money will be paid to the winning rider. Connections of the horse must organise the prize money split, if any, between themselves.

Any horses and riders competing in the TSHA Showjumping Thoroughbred classes 1.05m and over must also hold EA registration
